2. Abstract files in doc. format (Word 97-2003) should be **submitted by March 20, 2025** to e-mail: movnapid1@karazin.ua (*example of abstract file name: abstract_Petrenko_I.P._Karazin_KhNU_Kharkiv_Ukraine*).

Abstract Format Requirements: Length: up to 2 pages (in Ukrainian or English); Font: Times New Roman, 14 pt; Line spacing: single; Margins: 2 sm on all sides; Text emphasis: use italics and bold (not underlining); First line indent: 1.25; References in text: use square brackets [2: 27]. No page numbers or headers/footers.

Abstract formatting structure: title - centered in capital letters, bold; skip one line; author's surname and initials in bold; next line - country, city, and full name of institution in bold italics; skip one line, main text (justified alignment). Skip one line before References section (Times New Roman, 12 pt; single-spaced; first line indent 1.25; justified alignment) arranged alphabetically.
