INTRODUCTION

The work program of the educational discipline "Leadership and Teambuilding in Educational Institutions" is developed in accordance with the educational-professional (educational-scientific) program of training in "Educational and Pedagogical Sciences" at the third (educational-scientific) level of specialization 011 Educational and Pedagogical Sciences.

1. Description of the discipline

- 1.1 The aim of teaching this discipline is to prepare competent educators and researchers capable of effectively fulfilling their professional duties by acquiring knowledge in leadership theory, mastering practical tools for realizing leadership potential, efficient management, administration, and team building.
 - 1.2. The primary objectives of studying this discipline are as follows:
- to makepost-graduate students master the knowledge of the essence and content of the concepts of leadership and team building.
 - to impart the fundamentals of managing dynamics, motivation, and team cohesion.
- to encourage future educators and researchers to engage in continuous professional and personal development based on the implementation of a leadership mindset and behaviour, effective team management, and constructive communication among all team members.
- to facilitate the development of general and specific (professional) competencies in students pursuing higher education at the third (educational-scientific) level, which are essential for pedagogical and academic staff.

The discipline 'Leadership and Teambuilding in Educational Institutions' ensures that learners acquire the following competencies:

- CC 1 ability to generalize, analyze and synthesize, abstract and critical thinking for understanding researched pedagogical phenomena and processes, establishment of cause-and-effect relationships between them;

7. Teaching methods

Lectures, brainstorming sessions, roundtable discussions, webinars, multimedia presentations, practical tasks and exercises, meetups, infographics, working with educational and scientific literature, independent work using digital technologies and tools.

8. Control methods

Oral survey; checking written exercises and tasks; preparation and work in the classroom; control works of thematic and modular control; final control (offset). Assessment of educational achievements takes place on a 100-point scale during the semester. During the semester, the applicant for all types and forms of work can receive 60 points, adding a credit - 40 points.
