# 1. Description of the academic discipline

**1.1. The purpose** of teaching the academic discipline is the formation and development of Ukrainian-language communicative competence of foreign students of higher education in the educational and socio-cultural spheres of communication.

#### 1.2. The main tasks of studying the discipline:

- formation and development of foreign students' language and speech abilities and skills in all types of speech activities with the aim of mastering the state language of the country of study and meeting communicative needs in educational and socio-cultural communication in the Ukrainian language;
- students' mastery of various forms of communication in the educational and socio-cultural spheres of communication;
- formation of general competences:
- GC2. Ability to communicate with representatives of other professional groups of different levels (with experts from other fields of knowledge types of economic activity);
- GC3. Skills in the use of information and communication technologies;
- GC5. Ability to act on the basis of ethical considerations (motives);
- GC7. Ability to abstract thinking, analysis and synthesis;

#### 2. The thematic plan of the discipline

#### Topic 1. Phonetic and graphic system of the Ukrainian language. Ukrainian etiquette.

Ukrainian alphabet: letters and sounds. System of Ukrainian vowels and consonants. Use of soft sign and apostrophe. The concept of emphasis. Types of intonation constructions.

Use of Ukrainian etiquette expressions (greetings, farewells, requests, thanks, etc.).

#### Topic 2. Noun. Acquaintance. Family.

General information about the noun in the Ukrainian language. Gender of nouns. Formation of plural forms of nouns.

Acquaintance. Family members.

## **Topic 3. Pronoun. Student's personal belongings.**

Personal and possessive pronouns in the Ukrainian language. Gender and number of possessive pronouns. "Whose" questions?

The most necessary personal belongings of a student, which are constantly used in everyday life.

#### Topic 4. Verb. Studying at the university.

Infinitive. Formation of forms of the present, past and compound future tense of verbs.

Student's work in class and on homework.

#### Topic 5. Adjective. Adverb. My city.

The use of adjectives in the Ukrainian language (questions which?). Gender and number of adjectives. Agreement of adjectives with nouns and personal pronouns. Adverbs of action (question how?).

Description of the student's hometown and Kharkiv.

## Topic 6. Numeral. Days of the week and months in Ukrainian. Lessons schedule.

Designation of the number of items. Use of quantitative numerals (the question how many?). Designation of the order of objects when counting (the question which?). Kind and number of ordinal numerals.

# 7. Teaching methods

To achieve educational goals, the following teaching methods are used: conscious-practical as the leading method of teaching foreign languages; explanatory and illustrative; reproductive (reproducing what has been learned on the basis of a sample or rule in situations similar to the presented sample); method of problem-based teaching; partial search, or heuristic method (presupposes the organization of an active search for a solution to the tasks set by the teacher); research method.

#### 8. Forms of control

Current control is carried out at each practical session. With its help, the level of formation of skills and abilities in all types of speech activity in the relevant spheres of communication is checked.

Final control on a two-level scale (in written form) is conducted at the end of the 1st semester.

In order to be admitted to the final examination (credit), the student of higher education must score at least 30 points in the academic discipline during the current examination, independent work, individual task.

#### Criteria for evaluating educational achievements

A student can score from 1 to 60 points in practical classes during the semester and for a test.

From 0 to 10 points are awarded for each studied topic, of which: performance of lexical and grammatical tasks - 0-2 points, answers to questions - 0-2 points, production of monologue statements on a given topic - 0-2 points, participation in dialogic speech - 0-2 points, doing hometasks - 0-2 points.

The credit work is evaluated at a maximum of 40 points and involves the performance of lexical and grammatical tasks on the topics studied during the semester (3 tasks, the maximum number of points for each task is 10 points), and writing a monologue on the proposed topic.

- 1) Completion of lexical and grammatical tasks 30 points (1 point is awarded for each correct task, knowledge of the grammatical norms of the Ukrainian language is assessed).
- 2) Writing a monologue statement (at least 7 sentences) on a proposed educational or sociocultural topic 10 points (correspondence to the topic is evaluated (does not correspond, partially corresponds, corresponds) 0-3 points, completeness of the statement (elementary, fragmentary, incomplete, full) 0-3 points, compliance with language norms (does not meet, partial, full) 0-4 points).
