File with abstracts in \*doc format (Word 97-2003 Document) send **by April 15, 2024** to e-mail: **s.varava@karazin.ua** (example of file name with theses: theses\_I.P.Petrenko\_V.N.Karazin KhNU\_Kharkiv\_Ukraine).

Requirements for writing abstracts: volume of abstracts - up to 2 (two) pages (in Ukrainian or English); font – Times New Roman, 14 pt.; interval – 1; field - 2 cm on all sides; for text selections, use italics and bold font (not underlining); references to the "List of used sources" in the text should be placed in square brackets according to the model: [2: 27]. A complete list of sources should be provided at the end of the text under the title "References" (font 12 pt.) alphabetically. Do not number pages, do not use footers.

The text of theses should be drawn up as follows: title - in the center in bold type, one line is omitted, on the next line in bold type - surname, initials of the author / authors; on the next line in bold italics - the country, city and full name of the university; one line blank, followed by the main text (width alignment).
